Description:

Android apps are typically cross-compiled on more powerful computers, which prevents billions of people — especially those with only low-end phones and limited or no Internet access — from developing the apps they need. This talk introduces **Code On the Go**, a free and open-source Integrated Development Environment designed to run natively on low-end Android devices.

The session will demonstrate how this IDE enables offline app development on small-screen, soft-keyboard devices, and will highlight its novel capabilities that remove long-standing barriers to mobile-only software creation.
